



**Instructions:**

- (1) Cut around the outside of the pattern.
- (2) Lightly score each of the lines, making sure to score to the very end of each line at the centre of the pattern.
- (3) Pre-fold each of the fold lines, making dashed lines hill folds, and solid lines valley folds — the lines are not straight, so the paper will bend as you do this.
- (4) Cajole the whole pattern into folding — it gets easier with practice!

The pattern is very sensitive to small changes in geometry, which could be introduced by photocopying. You should get better results by folding a copy printed full size from the source file available from the web site, <http://www2.eng.cam.ac.uk/~sdg/dstruct/wrapping.html>.
